Pursuant to Section 4 of the Natural Gas Act ("NGA"), Part 154 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC" or "Commission") regulations, Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, and the Commission's May 29, 2025 Order Accepting and Suspending Tariff Records, Subject to Refund, and Establishing Hearing Procedures in Docket No. RP25-855-000 ("Suspension Order"), Great Lakes Gas Transmission Limited Partnership ("Great Lakes") hereby submits as part of its FERC Gas Tariff, Third Revised Volume No. 1 ("Tariff") this Type 580⁴ compliance filing to place into effect on November 1, 2025 an updated tariff record contained in Great Lakes' Section 4 rate case filing submitted on April 30, 2025, in Docket No. RP25-855-000 ("Rate Case Filing"), as further discussed below. Great Lakes request that the Commission reject now as moot the applicable originally filed tariff sheet contained in the Rate Case Filing⁵ and accept the substitute tariff record, included herein as Appendix A, effective November 1, 2025.

Statement of the Nature, Reasons and Basis for Filing

On April 30, 2025, in Docket No. RP25-855-000, Great Lakes filed revised tariff records as part of its Rate Case Filing. By its Suspension Order, the Commission accepted and suspended Great Lakes' tariff records to become effective upon motion November 1, 2025, subject to refund and the outcome of the hearing procedures established in the Suspension Order. ⁷

The purpose of this filing is to comply with Paragraph D of the Suspension Order, which provides that upon Great Lakes' motion to place the suspended rates into effect, Great Lakes must remove facilities not placed into service before November 1, 2025, the effective date of the suspended rates. Additionally, Great Lakes is revising Part 6.16.1 due to an administrative oversight in the Rate Case Filing. The change was indicated by shippers as an inconsistency and is reflected in Appendix A. A marked version of the tariff record is included herein as Appendix B. Great Lakes respectfully requests that the Commission reject as moot the applicable suspended tariff record submitted with the Rate Case Filing and accept the tariff record as contained in Appendix A.

As set forth in Appendix C, included herein, Great Lakes has revised the plant in-service balances for each of its facilities to reflect anticipated plant balances as of October 31, 2025. Appendix C includes cost-of-service Statements A through M, and all supporting schedules and workpapers, in native format. The statements and schedules within Appendix C reflect anticipated changes to accounts and allocations

dependent upon plant balances as of October 31, 2025. The update to Appendix C results in no change to the transportation rates filed in Great Lakes' Rate Case Filing.

Motion to Place Tariff into Effect

Pursuant to Section 154.206 of the Commission's Regulations and Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Great Lakes hereby moves to place the tariff record included herein as Appendix A, into effect November 1, 2025, and requests that the Commission reject as moot the applicable tariff record contained in the Rate Case Filing. Great Lakes requests that the Commission grant any waivers necessary for the proposed tariff record to become effective as requested herein.

Other Filings Which May Affect this Proceeding

Contemporaneously with the instant filing, Great Lakes is filing a separate Type 610 motion in Docket No. RP25-855-000 to move into effect certain tariff records from the Rate Case Filing that are not subject to modification.

- (a) Transporter shall notify Shipper twelve (12) months prior to the expiration of an existing Agreement of the impending termination, or may notify Shipper of Transporter's exercise of any contractual right to terminate the existing Agreement. Within fifteen (15) days of Transporter's notification, Shipper shall provide to Transporter:
 - (1) a written response stating that Shipper wishes to exercise its right of first refusal pursuant to this Section 6.16, including the quantity, if any, for which Shipper does not wish the provisions of this Section 6.16 to apply; or
 - (2) a written response stating that Shipper does not wish to exercise its right of first refusal.

Nothing in this section shall preclude Shipper from renewing the existing Agreement pursuant to Section 5.1.2 paragraph 1(b) of Rate Schedule FT and Section 5.2.2(j)(2) of Rate Schedule EFT or Section 5.3.2(g)(2) of Rate Schedule LFT, as applicable.

- (b) Shipper's failure to provide within fifteen (15) days of Transporter's notification the written response required by Section 6.16.1(a) shall constitute an irrevocable waiver of Shipper's right of first refusal.
- (c) Nothing in this section shall require Transporter to discount below the maximum rate applicable to a Transportation Service nor shall Transporter be required to agree to any other terms.
